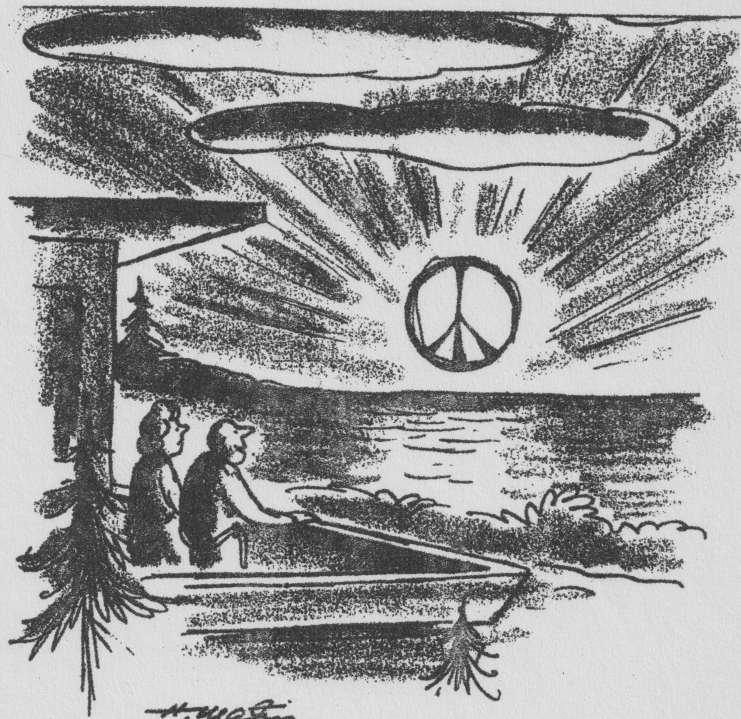


Xmas '69
